With reference to the Lok Sabha Unstarred Question No. 3273 dated 12/08/2024 by Shri Selvaganapathi T.M. regarding Campus Recruitment please find the reply from NIT Raipur stated below:

(a) whether it is fact that only 7% of colleges in the country achieve cent percent campus placement :

This question is not directly related to NIT Raipur, however, NIT Raipur achieves campus placement between 70%-85%, depending on the employment scenario in the country. Also, many students want to pursue higher education, civil services and government jobs, hence they opt out of the campus placement process which mainly provides opportunity for private sector companies.

(b) whether it is also a fact that the top challenges for a significant percentage of recruiters are the skill gap and inability to find the right talent:

This question is not directly related to NIT Raipur, however, as per feedback received from recruiters of NIT Raipur, the top challenges for campus placement of few students are lack of interpersonal skills, lack of aptitude and logical reasoning skills and lack of industrial exposure.

(c) whether it is also true that the skill gap and lack of preparation are major challenges in campus recruitment:

This question is not directly related to NIT Raipur, however, as per feedback received from recruiters of NIT Raipur, the top challenges for campus placement of few students are lack of interpersonal skills, lack of aptitude and logical reasoning skills and lack of industrial exposure.

(d) If so, the steps proposed to be taken by the Government to ensure maximum percentage of campus recruitment?

This question is not directly related to NIT Raipur, however, steps taken by NIT Raipur to improve placement of students are to impart training to all students for development of interpersonal skills, aptitude and logical reasoning and to provide industrial exposure.

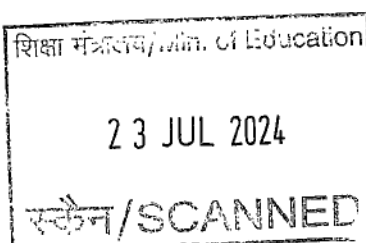
