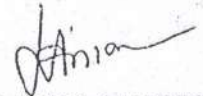

NOTIFICATION

Consequent upon approval by the Union Cabinet to the proposal of the Government of Chhattisgarh regarding upgradation of the Engineering College, Raipur as National Institute of Technology, the Central Government hereby takes over the full administrative and financial control of the above Institute. This notification will come into force with effect from 01.12.2005. Hereafter, the Engineering College, Raipur shall be known as National Institute of Technology (NIT), Raipur.

2. The NIT, Raipur would be integrated with other National Institutes of Technology in terms of academic and administrative practices from the academic session 2006-2007. However, the Institute would be given grant-in-aid under Plan & Non-Plan from the current financial year i.e. 2005-2006 in accordance with the approved pattern of assistance as applicable to other National Institutes of Technology.

3. All liabilities of the aforesaid Institute up to 30.11.2005 shall be borne by the State Government of Chhattisgarh. Further, detailed terms & conditions governing the service conditions of all the employees in the Institute as on 1.12.2005 would be notified separately. In the meanwhile, the Institute would prepare a detailed Register of Assets & Liabilities as on 1.12.2005. Further, the Institute shall be governed in accordance with the instructions to be issued by the Ministry of Human Resource Development (Department of Secondary & Higher Education) from time to time hereafter. In the absence of any instruction, it shall be governed by the general order as applicable to similar other Centrally funded institutions.
