Objective:

The purpose of this course is to provide up-gradation of knowledge and skills for research scholars/faculties/scientists involved in active research. The five days short term course will include lectures, special case studies on the areas of Applied Mathematics as well as a hand on practical experience on LaTeX..

Theme/Scope:

The five day STTP on “**Current Trends in Applied Mathematics: Applications and Future Aspects**” will bring together a group of experts in Algebra, Functional Analysis, Operational Research, Numerical Analysis, Probability and Statistics in NITRR. This is a scientific and technological character event and aim to bring together professionals working in AICTE approved engineering colleges and persons work in Industry / R & D Organizations, students and researchers of engineering and related sciences. The scope of the presentations will include theoretical development of security systems, generalized inverses of matrices & operators, probability & statistics and operations research issues from a problem-orientated perspective, scientific computing technologies, and any interdisciplinary combination that is not yet standard in the field. This programme will introduce LaTeX for beginners, and is one of its first kind in the state of Chhattisgarh. The STTP will also address all-level researchers, and is aimed to help shaping future research directions and creating opportunities for new interdisciplinary collaborations.

- Basic theory on Generalized inverses and its applications
- The fundamentals of optimization theory and algorithms
- Probability & Statistics and its applications in business and industry

- Introduction to advanced crypto systems
- Typesetting Journal articles, technical reports, books, thesis and slide preparation
